# **Presentation Reminders [Orals and Posters]**

Dear ICCV2013 presenter,

Please find below all the information you need for your presentation day. Kindly follow the instructions to enable a smooth conference.

### Oral and Spotlight sessions:

- The first row of chairs in the conference room will have numbered seats for all speakers (orals and spotlights). Please take the correct seat before the session starts.
- **Oral presenters** should be present at the podium at least 15 minutes before the start of the session and should introduce themselves to the session chair as soon as they arrive. *Please note the November 25<sup>th</sup> deadline for submitting your Release Form, see details below.*
- **Spotlight presenters** must be in their respective seat **before** the end of the preceding oral session. *Please note the November 25<sup>th</sup> deadline for submitting your spotlight slides, see details below.*
- For both Oral and Poster papers, please make sure you read the information below regarding the "Techtalks Recording Release Form."
- If you require any special assistance during your talk or to get to the podium, please let the session chair know of this before the session.
- Oral speakers should test their own laptops with the projector before the session, to avoid any technical difficulties.
- Oral talks are given 13 minutes plus 2 minutes for questions. You will be asked to leave the podium once your time is up, please make sure you do not exceed the given time limit.
- Spotlight speakers will be ushered to the podium by a volunteer when their talk is due. You are given 5 seconds to take your place, and introduce yourself. After these 5 seconds the intro slide will flip to your content slide which will then be displayed for 45 seconds. There will be only a fixed microphone in the podium. All slides will run automatically, so please leave the podium once your slide is flipped. Note that you will not have access to the laptop (applies only to the spotlight presenters).
- Recall that all "clickable" animations have been removed from the spotlight presentations. You
  will not have access to the laptop to advance the slides or go back. All "timed" presentations have
  been preserved and checked.

### **Poster sessions:**

- Each poster is assigned a specific board identified by paper number. Check with the volunteers or the registration desk if you cannot find your poster board. The physical dimension of the poster board is 2000mm wide and 900mm high?
- Your poster will be displayed only during your poster session, so be reminded to remove your poster after your session. Otherwise, they will be removed and discarded.

## **Oral Presentations:**

At the conference, each oral presenter will be given 13 minutes to present his/her work leaving 2 minutes for questions. Please prepare the content of your talk accordingly. Make sure to introduce yourself to the session chair at least 10 minutes before the start of your session.

## **Poster Spotlight Sessions**

Each poster in ICCV'2013 will also have a spotlight presentation. Each spotlight presenter will give a very short (50-second hard limit) elevator pitch to advertise his/her poster. Roughly, each spotlight presenter has:

- 2 seconds to walk to the podium (title slide on)
- 3 seconds to introduce yourself (title slide still on)
- 45 seconds to talk about the poster (poster slide on)

We recommend each presenter rehearses accordingly. Approximately 52 spotlight presentations are scheduled after each of the first two oral sessions on each day and will take place in the main hall where the conference orals are presented. Note that the intention of the spotlights is to draw people's attention to the posters and are NOT meant to be mini-talks. Presentations will be scheduled on the same day as and right before the associated posters. The preliminary program is available here: <a href="Preliminary Program">Preliminary Program</a>.

We ask the authors of each poster to prepare a one slide summary presentation using the following template:

Please amend the template as follows:

- 1 Title slide: Please replace the name, date, and time of your poster spotlight session (according to <u>the program</u>) from the list below:
  - Session 1A: Tuesday Morning, December 3<sup>rd</sup>
  - Session 1B: Tuesday Afternoon, December 3<sup>rd</sup>
  - Session 2A: Wednesday Morning, December 4th
  - Session 2B: Wednesday Afternoon, December 4<sup>th</sup>
  - Session 3A: Thursday Morning, December 5<sup>th</sup>
  - Session 3B: Thursday Afternoon, December 5<sup>th</sup>
  - Session 4A: Friday Morning, December 6<sup>th</sup>
  - Session 4B: Friday Afternoon, December 6<sup>th</sup>

Also, provide the title and authors of the paper and please <u>UNDERLINE</u> the author giving the spotlight talk. This slide will display for only 5 seconds.

2 - The second slide should give a brief summary of the approach taken in the paper and/or the most interesting results obtained by the approach. Feel free to include pictures. However, do not include any videos or clickable animations in the slide. You will only have 45 seconds on this slide. Think of it as a commercial for your paper to motivate people to come to your poster to learn more (most commercials are only 30-60 seconds).

Please enter your poster ID into the top-left field of the slide. The poster ID is in the format P<SessionID>-<Poster #>. The poster # is found by referring to the program. For example, if you are the 4th poster in spotlight session 3B, your poster ID is P3B-04. Please do not change the font size or type.

- 3 There is a strict limit of one spotlight slide per presentation (in addition to the title slide). If multiple spotlight slides are submitted, only the first one will be included in the program. There will also be a hard limit of 50 seconds per spotlight--with slides advancing automatically--so please prepare the content and presentation accordingly.
- 4 Please name your PowerPoint presentation XXXX.ppt where XXXX is the four-digit CMT paper ID (zero-padded if necessary). For example, if your CMT paper ID is 24, the filename must be 0024.ppt. Submit the .ppt file containing the presentation through CMT at <a href="https://cmt.research.microsoft.com/ICCV2013/">https://cmt.research.microsoft.com/ICCV2013/</a>.

The slides will be put together into a single file for each session, which necessitates a single format. Thus submit the presentation in the Powerpoint format (as the given template) and make sure it is compatible with Windows XP. Please test the presentation before submitting.

**DEADLINE:** Slides for the spotlight are due by Monday, November 25 (11:59 PM PST). This is a hard deadline, and we will not be accepting the presentations nor any changes or additions after the deadline (presentations not received by the deadline will not be included in the spotlight session).

#### Additional Details:

- Presenters will NOT have access to the computer on which the presentations will run. All
  spotlights in the same session will be compiled into a single presentation, and slides will
  automatically advance.
- The first (title) slide of each presentation will be shown for exactly 5 seconds during which the microphone will be handed over to the presenter and the presenter will introduce himself/herself, the authors and the title of the paper.
- The second slide will be shown for exactly 45 seconds. This timing is strict and you are kindly asked to leave the podium for the next presenter after the 50 seconds are up.
- Clickable animations are NOT accepted and will be removed if found during the process of compiling the session's presentation.
- Timed animations can be used yet we do not advise you to do so, as the timing on your machine can differ slightly from the timing on the laptop used at the venue. Ensure that your talk is flexible and you are not surprised by such slight variations. There will be no chance to check or practice your presentation using the laptop beforehand.
- Embedded GIF animations can be used in the slides but we would not allow video files.

# **Techtalks Recording Release Form**

Both the Oral sessions and the Poster Spotlight Sessions will be webcast and subsequently archived on <a href="http://techtalks.tv">http://techtalks.tv</a>. In order to provide this service to the community we need at least one representative from each paper (both oral and poster) to sign a recording release form. • **DEADLINE:** Please scan the signed release form and upload it to the CMT system at <a href="https://cmt.research.microsoft.com/ICCV2013/">https://cmt.research.microsoft.com/ICCV2013/</a> by Monday, November 25th, 2013 at the latest. Please name the file as "PaperID\_ReleaseForm.pdf," where PaperID should be the four digits ID of your paper in CMT with necessary zero padding. For example, if your paper ID is 24, you should name the file as 0024 ReleaseForm.pdf.

For oral presentations, we will also need your presentation slides for video synchronization. However, these will be collected after the conference.
